

Required Coaching Licenses & Diplomas

To become a CIT:

- Coach obtain 2 hour on line USSF “F” License
- Coach obtain on line NSCAA diploma
- Player Development Curriculum Stage 2 for 6 - 8 years



During CIT time of 9s and 10s (to be considered for 11s coach)

- Coaches obtain one weekend USSF course “E” License
- Coaches obtain online NSCAA diploma titled
- Player Development Curriculum Stage 3 for 9 - 11 years
- Attend Technical Director and/or Director of Coaching coaches clinics

Extra: Attend level I or II or III NSCAA Diploma

As 11s Coach (to be considered for 12s coach)

- Coaches obtain online NSCAA diploma titled
- Player Development Curriculum Stage 4 for 12 - 14 years
- Coaches obtain online NSCAA diploma course suggested by Technical Director
- Attend Technical Director coaches clinics
- Attend Level V or VI NSCAA Diploma course

As 12s Coach (to be considered for 13s coach)

- Coaches obtain two weekend USSF course “D” License
- Coaches obtain online NSCAA diploma titled
- Player Development Curriculum Stage 5 for 13 - 15 years
- Attend Technical Director coaches clinics

Extra: Attend NSCAA National Diploma course

As 13s and/or 14s coach (to be considered for 15 coach)

- Obtain USSF "C" license



Age group breakdown of coaching requirements:

100% of requirement need for consideration of coaching position. Coaches may be paid or unpaid depending on qualifications of parents on the team. All teams will still work with a Staff Coach at least once a week.
